Revoke a portion of Emergency Rule 8-3-21.A(13) closing Boulder Airport after 5:00 p.m. on September 12, 2013 and open Boulder Airport to the public after 2:00 p.m. on September 18, 2013, while still permitting emergency responders to camp in areas designated for this purpose at the Boulder Airport. Notwithstanding the provisions of Sections 5-6-10, 8-3-21, B.R.C. 1981, such individuals shall be permitted to employ appropriate camping equipment including tents or other temporary structures.

The Boulder Airport shall be open to the public beginning 2:00 p.m. on September 18, 2013 and emergency responders will be permitted to camp in designated areas at the airport. Notwithstanding the provisions of Sections 5-6-10, 8-3-21, B.R.C. 1981, such individuals shall be permitted to employ appropriate camping equipment including tents or other temporary structures.
