The City of Boulder's stream, wetland and water body permitting requirements are hereby suspended, under specified conditions, until 8 a.m. on October 16, 2013 to facilitate response to and recovery from extensive flooding in the city. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 9-3-9, B.R.C. 1981, the city or its contractors may perform regulated activities within regulated areas without a stream, wetland or water body permit for work related to flood recovery and repair.
