

IS THE COST OF CHILD CARE A PROBLEM FOR YOU?

If you're having trouble affording the child care you want for your children, the *Child Care Subsidy and Referrals Program (CCSR)* CLIFF subsidies might be able to help. The Program is designed to give families with low income greater options for choosing child care that meets their family's needs.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR CLIFF ASSISTANCE?

- You must live in the City of Boulder
- You must need child care because you are working or enrolled in an eligible training or educational activity
- You must be denied for the Colorado Child Care Assistance Program (CCCAP) or be Over income for CCCAP
- You must have a household income that does not exceed these amounts:

<u>For family size of :</u>	2	3	4	5	6	7
<u>Monthly gross income must be less than to qualify for Cliff benefits</u>	\$3,932	\$4,948	\$5,963	\$6,977	\$7,993	\$9,008

HOW DOES THE CHILD CARE SUBSIDY AND REFERRALS (CCSR) CLIFF PAYMENTS WORK?

- **If your family income fits the chart above but you are not eligible for the CCCAP program**, the CCSR Program may pay a portion of your monthly child care costs. The payment is made directly to your child care provider and you pay the rest of the fee. The fee you pay varies depending on household size and income.

HOW DO I APPLY Cliff?
