


# South Boulder Creek Floodplains



## EXPLANATION OF ZONE DESIGNATIONS

ZONE	EXPLANATION
 AE Zone	Defined as areas of special flood hazard inside the 100-year floodplain where water surface elevations have been determined. A 100-year flood event is a flood that has a one-percent chance of being equaled or exceeded in any given year.
 X Shaded	Defined as areas of moderate flood hazard that are determined to be within the 500-year floodplain where there is a 0.2-percent chance of being equaled or exceeded in any given year; areas in the 100-year floodplain where average depths are less than one foot; and areas protected by levees from the 100-year flood.
X Unshaded	Areas determined to be outside 500-year floodplain
