KIDS' CORNER

Our goal is to provide a safe, memorable experience for your child to give you peace of mind while you work out. To help us meet this goal, please read & observe our regulations. Thank you.

HOURS OF OPERATION

North (NBRC)

Monday thru Friday.....8:45 a.m. – 1:30 p.m.

Tuesday/Thursday.....2:30 p.m. – 6:30 p.m.

East (EBCC)

Monday/Wednesday..... 2:30 p.m. – 6:30 p.m.

Friday/Saturday.....8:30 a.m. – 1:30 p.m.

FEES

Drop-in fee includes 90 minutes of care*:

\$6.50 first child/ \$3.50 each additional child

Punch cards*:

\$58.50.....10 Punch (\$5.85/visit)

\$110.50....20 Punch (\$5.50/visit)

\$195.00....40 Punch (\$4.90/visit)

*Additional 30 minutes may be purchased for \$2.

Available for children 2 and older only.

*Maximum 2 hours of care.

Annual membership benefit:

\$25/month pass (1 visit per day per session)

Must have an adult annual pass to purchase.

2+ years may stay for up to 2 hours with this pass.

LABELING ITEMS

Please label all of your child's belongings. The Recreation Center assumes no responsibility for lost or stolen items.

ADMISSIONS

- We accept ages 6 months to 9 years. Numbers are based on a 6:1 child:staff ratio and staff discretion.
- Childcare is available for parents and/or caregivers who have registered for a class, paid to use the facility, or are participating in a program.
Parents/caregivers are required to check themselves in at the front desk and be on recreation property at all times.
- If you are using the Iris Studio, the tennis courts, or exercising on the grounds, you must be reachable via cell phone.
- *Arrival & departure:* Please check in at front desk and present your receipt for childcare when you enter the Kids' Corner. Each child must be signed in and out daily. The person signing out the child must be on your registration pick-up list. Please inform us when you drop off if someone else will be picking up your child.

SUNSCREEN

On sunny days, we love to let our kids play outside in our wonderful play area. Our childcare is not licensed to apply sunscreen, so we ask you to apply as you wish before heading to your workout. We have sunscreen available for your use.

LATE PICK-UPS

Please plan your workouts accordingly. The time limit of 90 or 120 minutes begins when you arrive. Chronic late pick-ups will be grounds for dismissal.

SNACK

We encourage you to send your child with a healthy snack. Even if they've eaten recently, when children see other children eating, they often want to join the group. Nuts, hard candy and gum are not permitted in the Kids' Corner. Please label your snacks.

For the safety of those with nut allergies, the Kids' Corner is a **NUT-FREE ZONE**. Please do not send your child with any snacks that contain nuts. If you send a snack with nuts, it will not be opened or served.

WELLNESS

If your child becomes ill while in our care, parents will be contacted and asked to pick up their child immediately. The recreation center is not licensed to provide care for sick children. Parents/caregivers must pick up an ill child within 10 minutes of being contacted.

Staff of the Kids' Corner have the authority to ask parents to remove a child if the child appears ill or his/her health is judged to be detrimental to other children and staff. A temperature over 100 degrees is our guideline for fevers. When a child has an unusual or suspicious rash, we must have a doctor's note to confirm that the child is not contagious.

Children exhibiting these symptoms are asked to stay home:

- a fever in the past 24 hours
- an upper respiratory illness such as infectious bronchitis or influenza
- diarrhea, vomiting, bloody stools or stools containing mucus
- rash (we must have a doctor's note to confirm that the child is not contagious)
- pink eye and/or yellow discharge from the eye
- mouth sores that cause excessive drooling
- head lice
- strep throat

CONTACTING PARENTS/CAREGIVERS

If staff members need to contact you, they will first page over the rec center intercom. If you do not arrive within 5-10 minutes, staff will attempt to locate you, either by calling your cell phone or in person. We will attempt to contact you for the following reasons:

- Diaper change needed
- Upset child (crying more than 10 min.)
- Injury/illness
- Repeated behavior problems

DIAPERS/POTTY TRAINING

As a drop-in service only, we are not licensed to change diapers. Please drop your child off in a clean diaper and know we'll come find you if your child needs changing.

If your child is potty training, we will try to help by taking them to the bathroom when needed. To ensure cleanliness of our facility, please send your child in a pull-up or plastic pants. Children must wear underwear or a diaper in our facility.

BEHAVIOR

Redirection is the first logical step to behavior management. Should a problem persist, natural consequences and removal from the activity will be used as a form of discipline. In the event that a chronic behavior problem develops, incidents will be documented & communicated to the parent/caregiver. The following behaviors are unacceptable and may result in the immediate suspension of a child for the remainder of the day and/or a longer time.

- Endangering or threatening to endanger the health and safety of others, self or staff.
- Stealing or damaging NBRC, EBCC or personal property.
- Continuous disruption of the program
- Using profanity, vulgarity or obscenities
- Acting in a lewd manner

EVACUATION

In the case of an evacuation, children will be taken to the following locations, where parents/caregivers may sign out their children if they wish:
EBCC: flagpole in front of building
NBRC: tennis courts
