

# **Chautauqua 2020 Stewardship Framework**

## **Draft Principles and Evaluation Criteria**

### **Principles**

1. Preserve Chautauqua's historic character while addressing current and future needs.
2. Support Chautauqua's historic mission to provide cultural, educational, social and recreational activities to benefit visitors, residents and the greater Boulder community.
3. When addressing changes to programs offered by or on Chautauqua's grounds, look first to management (vs. constructed) solutions.
4. Support economically, environmentally and socially sustainable solutions to issues that exist or that arise.
5. Recognize and balance the interests of the multiple jurisdictions at Chautauqua: CCA and its lessees, P&R and OSMP.
6. Support a pedestrian-based experience.

### **Criteria**

1. Minimize and/or mitigate impact to adjacent lands and neighbors.
2. Optimize use of existing infrastructure.
3. Encourage use of multi-modal systems.
4. Demonstrate the City's and CCA's sustainable ethic and goals.
5. Minimize or mitigate vehicular traffic and parking impacts within the Chautauqua campus and the surrounding area.
6. Improve health and/or life safety.
7. Promote sustainable, year-round use of existing facilities. (Redistribute peak uses.)
8. Support reinvestment in infrastructure and/or programs.
9. Minimize impacts to historic fabric.
