AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR SUBMITTING TO A VOTE OF THE  
QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF BOULDER,

The question of acquiring, establishing and maintaining certain public parks, pleasure grounds and boulevards.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOULDER:

SECTION 1. It is hereby declared that there shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the city of Boulder the question of acquiring the following described lands for the purpose of establishing and maintaining thereon public parks, pleasure grounds, boulevards, park ways, avenues and roads, to-wit:

*The East One Half (1/2) of the N.E. One Quarter (1/4) of Section One (1) T.P. 15, R. 71 N. of the 6th Principal Meridian*

in the County of Boulder and State of Colorado.

SECTION 2. The price to <sup>be</sup> paid for said lands is hereby limited to the sum of Eight thousand Dollars, which said price is to be paid in the manner following. to-wit:

*in Cash*

SECTION 3. Said election shall be held on the 5th day of April A.D. 1898, the same being the date for the regular annual election of said City in the respective wards of said City and at the several voting places as designated and established by ordinance. At such election those who desire to vote in favor of acquiring and purchasing said lands for said purposes at said price shall deposit a ballot with the following words thereon:

"For the acquirement of parks and the establishment of boulevards, park ways and roads."

Those desiring to vote against the acquiring and purchase of said lands for said purposes at said price shall deposit a ballot with the following words thereon:

"Against the acquirement of parks ~~or~~ the establishment of boulevards, park ways ~~or~~ roads."

SECTION 4. The City Clerk is hereby directed to give notice of said election according to law and incorporate in said notice this Ordinance.
