

**Junior Ranger Program frequently asked questions:**

If I worked last year, do I need to submit a new application?	YES
If I worked last year, do I need to submit a new reference form?	NO
If I applied last year but did not work, do I need to submit a new reference form?	YES
If I worked last year, am I guaranteed a job this year?	NO
Are positions competitive?	YES

How do I become a Junior Ranger?

Application to the program requires an online application, job reference and personal interview.

What if I'm too old to be a Junior Ranger?

Staff are recruited in March. Other seasonal jobs and volunteer opportunities exist with OSMP.

What's the difference between the Boulder County Youth Corps and Junior Ranger Program?

These programs are administered by separate agencies.

The Boulder County Youth Corps is an 8 week job sponsored by Boulder County.

The Junior Ranger Program is sponsored by City of Boulder Open Space and Mountain Parks and requires a five week commitment.
