Terracon is providing this letter on behalf of the City of Boulder as a response to your January 4, 2006 letter concerning the subject site.

In your January 4, 2006 letter you requested that the City conduct two of its action items slightly differently than as proposed in Terracon's December 16, 2005 "City of Boulder's Proposed Actions" letter. They are:

1. Conduct the gamma reading survey on a 10-meter by 10-meter grid and at prairie dog holes, rather than on a 100-meter by 100-meter grid; and use a cleanup level of 30uR/hr rather than 60 uR/hr.


The City agrees to conduct the survey in accordance with your suggestion and agrees to the 30uR/hr cleanup level. Terracon has modified the City's cap restoration design documents accordingly.

2. The lead level cleanup level should be 400 mg/Kg, rather than 800 mg/Kg.

The City agrees to accommodate your suggestion and Terracon has modified the City's cap restoration design documents accordingly.
