Dear Mr. Hendricks:

You are authorized to receive for deposit on your Valmont Tailings pile the material referenced in the attached letter of February 11, 1983 from Strategic Metals International, Inc. to the Boulder County Health Department. This authorization is contingent on the receipt and maintaining in force of any permits required by Boulder County and other government agencies, and upon the material being non-radioactive. The material is to be deposited on the tailings pile in a manner consistent with your maintenance of the containment of the radioactive material presently there.

You are cautioned to ensure that your tailings pile material adjacent to your North fence line along Valmont Road does not exceed the fence line. All of this material between your North dike and North fence line should be recovered to the tailings pile no later than the time that you add on to the present tailings dikes.
