



**DESCRIPTION:**  
 The preferred alternative concept plan creates distributed habitat restoration areas as well as distributed creek access and picnic areas. This concept limits large group creek access to the West end of the waterfront. Distributed access in smaller areas discourages large group activities elsewhere. Picnic areas of varying sizes, which are separated from the creek, allow for privacy and variation. Distributed habitat restoration allows existing vegetation to anchor habitat improvement areas along the waterfront. This concept allows for a "Naturalistic" treatment of the creek bank while allowing group recreation and private picnic areas.
