### Project Purpose and Scope of Work

The Valmont Rd and 29th St Safety and Multimodal Enhancements Project is intended to improve the future safety of bicyclists, pedestrians, and drivers at this intersection and enhance the bicycle and pedestrian facilities on Valmont Road. The project will include:

- Widening of Valmont Road at 29th Street for eastbound and westbound center left turn lanes
- Installation of a traffic signal at Valmont Rd and 29th St
- Bicycle and pedestrian facility enhancements including buffered bike lanes and signal with activation for pedestrians and bicyclists
- Landscaping restoration and replacement
- Roadway resurfacing or reconstruction
- Possible public art or urban design features

Location with large number of collisions involving pedestrians, bicyclists and/or vehicles


- From 2004-2010 over 60 collisions including 15 injuries and 1 fatality.

### Project Funding and Budget

The budget is \$3 million with \$2.7 million in federal Hazard Elimination Program (HEP) funds and \$300,000 in City of Boulder Transportation funds.

### During Construction anticipated travel impacts will be:

- Full time lane closure (s) on Valmont Road between 28th and 30th streets
  - On-street bicycle lane closures
- Some closures to lanes on 29th Street at Valmont Road
- Sidewalk closures on one side of the street at a time
- Business access will be maintained at all times with some short-term detours/closures to driveways on Valmont Road
